- -fast from pessimism and be filled with hope.
- -fast from worries and have trust in God
- -fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity
- -fast from pressures and be prayerful
- -fast from bitterness and fill your heart with joy
- -fast from selfishness and be compassionate to others

Our church is a hospital for sinners, not a museum for saints. So let us turn to the Lord with humility and entrust ourselves into his sacred wounds for healing and sanctification.
