### The Year of the God Who Speaks

The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England & Wales has designated the year from September 2019 to December 2020 as 'The Year of the God Who Speaks' It begins on September 20th on the Feast of St Jerome, the great scholar of the Bible and the first to translate it from Hebrew into Latin. The Year will end on 31st December 2020.

Before he retired, Bishop Tom Burns appointed Fr Jerome Ituah as a Scripture Champion to promote the 'Year of the God Who Speaks' in the Diocese of Menevia.. In our Diocese Archbishop George will pre-launch the Year of the Word in Carmarthen at 11am on Saturday October 19th at St Mary's Church. At the same time DOMSEC (see below) will be inaugurated. Please pick up a leaflet from the porch from the Archbishop.
