The Holy Father has published an Apostolic letter Motu Proprio instituting a particular Sunday in which to celebrate the Word of God. This will take place on 3rd Sunday Ordinary Time each year. Associated with this, is the joint work of the Bishop's Conference and the Bible Society project—The God Who Speaks: The Year of the Word in the Catholic Church in England & Wales 2020. The year 2020 sees the 10th anniversary of Verbum Domini, the Apostolic Exhortation of Pope Benedict XVI on the Word of the Lord. It is also the 1600th anniversary of St Jerome's death. For these strong reasons it is a good time to embark on a creative and deeper engagement with the Holy Scriptures in your personal lives and with our people.
